2012 Timeshare conference



In September we were lucky to have the annual Australian Timeshare & Holiday Ownership Council (ATHOC) conference in Nth Qld— Cairns. So it was just a drive versus a flight for most of us. 5 Directors were prepared to give up their time to attend. And after DECADES in the industry, Mark Tull was invited on to a discussion panel regarding the life cycle of timeshare ownership which was very thought provoking for us all. For the fully sold 'independent'

resorts (such as ours) there was much discussion regarding the future of schemes given the



increasing age of members and keeping members engaged with their holiday ownership; how to attract upcoming generations; and obviously lots of administrative topics like building codes, state awards, board matters & compliance issues. Again we re turned to Island Palms re-energised and stimulated. One of our first improvements, as mentioned by Mark, was to set up a resort owned wifi system so we can offer more reasonably priced internet to owners and guests (1 week \$20, 1 GB download limit; 1 day \$5,500MB download limit).

And for Island Palms Resort, another RCI "Hospitality" award PLUS RCI's "Silver Crown" award (the latter only our 2nd one in the past 10yrs - John must have changed his jokes or something).

IMPORANT REMINDER: As advised in the June 2012 newsletter, the Club no longer runs rental pools. As has always been the case, you may arrange the private rental of your entitlement — you need to first book a week by contacting the resort or if you have adequate time left before your entitlement expires, once you have an interested party, contact the resort so see if the date they want is available.

Around the resort

We had committed money from the current year budget to tackle wardrobe updates, but the aging resort guttering isn't going to last till the next budget year as we had hoped. So with the 'wet' season pending we have revised the budget priorities and will be spending \$25,000 on full resort guttering & downpipe replacement. Not as exciting but very necessary. Total job is expected to take approx 2 weeks and subject to weather will be tackled somewhere between 29.1-7.3.2013. As you can imagine, full resort height scaffolding & a cherry-picker is required. Job includes removal & replacement of existing guttering/downpipes. The (original) wooden structures over driveway side windows and drainage tubes from the old box unit air-cons will also be removed — which will be great to have already

done before a full resort exterior paint in the 2014/15 year. The new guttering will have a larger water capacity & quicker drainage. It's a semi-circular gutter, not rectangular, with external brackets and the downpipes will be larger than current—100mm round versus existing 50X75mm rectangular. With all the access and safety gear onsite, we will also get correct drainage for the rooftop solar hot water tanks fitted.

In the next couple of weeks we will refurbish 2 apartment laundrys — remove the sliding doors (original), replace the floor tiling (original), replace the sinks (original), paint & replace (original) splashback tiling. We'll also do a full internal re-paint of as many apartments as remaining time permits in February.

FINALLY ... the very unsightly window tinting is being removed and replaced, <u>HOOORAY!!!!</u> 8 apartments have been done, only 4 to go which will be complete over February/March.

The resort grounds look lovely and we receive lots of compliments. We must give most of the praise to Mike who helps around the resort. We personally joke that he is on a mission to singlehandedly fill with green waste all remaining land fill at the Picnic Bay tip!

2012 was a great year, in particular due to the larger than normal number of members we met for the first time, most who were visiting their resort for the first time in at least a decade or 2 or nearly 3! G'day Rick & Sandra (even though we saw you again recently); Vicki & Jim; John & Lynette; Fred & Jessie (2nd visit since 1988!); Barry & Coralie (first stay since purchasing in 1984—I think you win!); Allison (a close 2nd, last visit October 1987); Brian & Irene (approx 1993); and last through the door at the very end of 2012, Heather & Michael (early 1994).
